# Fun meets functional

Give your teen's room a makeover with these DIY ideas to help them embellish and organize.

## DIY Art

An inexpensive cork bulletin board can be used as a decorative frame to hang ribbons, necklaces, lanyards and medals. Adhere the fabric of your choice to the front of the board with spray glue and simply cut off the excess around the edges. Hang medals or ribbons in the center with a pushpin and you've created a custom three-dimensional wall display for your achievements.

Or, make a modern art installation. Take picture frames in different styles and sizes, and spray paint them in vibrant colors that match the bedroom's décor. Hang them directly



to the wall without the backing. Once installed, place a smaller photo frame or shelf in the center to make a unique presentation for collectibles.

Another option is to paint the actual wall inside the frame and leave it empty. Mix and match the wall colors and frames for a cool display.

## Stylish Storage

The front of your closet can make a fashion statement, too! Take raised panel closet doors and use them to organize accessories, jewelry, hats, purses, and scarves – anything and everything. Spray mount gift wrapping paper in graphic patterns to each of the raised panels, trim off the excess with a straight-edge and razor for a precision cut, and finally, attach adhesive Command damage-free hooks in coordinating colors to hang stuff. It becomes functional wall art!

Another idea is to repurpose baskets and shelving on the walls. Use baskets that come in an array of colors, sizes and materials. Secure them to the wall with anchors, finishing washers and screws. The exposed hardware gives it an industrial touch. You maximize storage by not only using the inside of the baskets as cubbyholes, but you can also display items on the top shelf. Wood crates hung next to the bed can function as floating night stands!

Thinking outside of the box and repurposing items you already have in simple do-it-yourself projects like these will not only save you money, but help your teen express their personality.
