

'Empire,' 'Grantchester' back in style

Cookie Lyon and the Rev. Sidney Chambers are back where they belong: in prime time.

The return of dashing Sidney in PBS' "Grantchester" should ease the pain of losing "Downton Abbey." Cookie's comeback on "Empire," at 9 p.m.

Wednesday on Fox, should please fans of overthe-top drama.

Cookie's conniving, clothing and chatter remain blissfully broad, thanks to Taraji P. Henson's take-no-prisoners approach to the role. The corporate intrigue for the Lyon family turned a bit repetitive in the fall, but "Empire" works to get its groove back with outrageous moves. Patriarch Lucious Lyon (Terrence Howard) fumes flamboyantly about losing his com-

The series ratchets up problems for the sons of Cookie and Lucious. Andre (Trai Byers) deals with loss, visions and marital clashes with Rhonda (Kaitlin Doubleday). Jamal (Jussie Smollett) faces a fan backlash over his personal life. Hakeem (Bryshere "Yazz" Gray) is busy with executive duties and a tangled love life that includes nasty Camilla (Naomi Campbell).

Life with mom Cookie is never easy, and it's never boring, because you don't know if she'll hit, hug or lecture. Wednesday's episode puts jaw-dropping spins on a corporate meeting and father-son relations.

The April 6 episode intensifies the family turmoil through the music. Smollett pulls off two strong numbers: a showy reply to Lucious and a tender song to comfort Andre. The latter is an electrifying change of pace for "Empire," which soon returns to its wild, astonishing

"Grantchester," set in 1950s England, starts a six-episode run at 9 tonight on "Masterpiece." Chambers (James Norton) is a brilliant, hunky vicar. He is also the earnest foil for cynical Inspector Geordie Keating (Robson Green) as they solve crimes.

First up, the men must uncover what happened to a saucy girl whose diary disrupts Sidney's life. The dark story explores smalltown desperation, sexual secrets and unsettling hypocrisy. The second episode takes espionage to far-fetched heights.

Yet Norton and Green form a strong team. Norton poignantly plays Sidney's anguish over a lost love and his struggles to move on. Norton makes you care as much about the man as the

Each week, Amado will show viewers how to renovate a room or outdoor space or seasonally decorate a home without spending a lot of money. The show will include South Florida real estate topics.

"We are going to help you make it right," said Amado, a Miami native who lives in Sunrise. "We are doing everything from interior to outdoor spaces. The majority of them are projects that the homeowners can do at home with minimal tools."

The first episode will take him to a home in Miramar, where he helps a woman find a creative solution to her collection of global masks and artifacts. Amado painted poster frames to make them look like custom molding to feature the masks on a living room wall.

A few ways to make noise about too-loud commercials

Questions and answers about TV shows past and present.

Q: Commercials, particularly the local ones, are just obnoxiously loud as compared to the show broadcast. I thought that there was a rule of "acceptable level" that was to be enforced by the FCC. So who is dropping the ball and whom should I contact?


A: I have an answer, although I don't think you will like it much.

Federal law includes the Commercial Advertisement Loudness Mitigation Act from 2010. FCC rules then apply the law's standards to "TV stations, cable operators, satellite TV operators and other pay TV providers to ensure television commercial advertisements have the same average volume as the programs that they accompany."

So why doesn't everything sound the same? Look at the word "average." As I understand the rules, the average loudness of the commercial is measured by averaging the loudness of all components of the sound (dialogue, background music and so on) over the length of the commercial. Then, the average loudness of the program is measured by averaging the loudness over the length of the program.

So if you come out of a quiet scene into a commercial, it may be loud compared to what you've just been listening to, but not loud on average.

The FCC adds that "you may be able to activate certain settings in your television or home theater system to help stabilize overall loudness. Many televisions and home theater systems have features to control loudness, such as automatic gain control, audio compression or audio limiters, that can be turned

on to provide a more constant volume level across programs and commercials. These functions usually need to be activated through the equipment's 'Set Up/Audio' menu."

If you still think something is wrong, you can complain one of three ways. By telephone: 888-CALL-FCC (888-225-5322); TTY to 888-TELL-FCC

Be sure to include your contact information and the details of your complaint.

Q: Can you tell me if there are plans for a third season of "Fargo"?

A: There are. According to published reports, the third season of the FX series will be set in 2010, about four years after the end of the first season. There will also be at least one character returning from earlier episodes, although it is not clear who. Entertainment Weekly said in January that a best bet is Lou Solverson, played by Keith Carradine in the first season and Patrick Wilson

in the second. But it also noted that series showrunner Noah Hawley "could just totally surprise us, as he tends to do."

Q: Michelle Dockery has a role on the upcoming TNT series "Good Behavior." Does it have an air date yet?

A: Not beyond "coming this fall," as TNT says on its website. Dockery, best known as Lady Mary on the now-done "Downton Abbey," plays a thief and con artist in what the network calls a "seductive thriller based on the Letty Dobesh books by Blake Crouch." A TNT executive has said that "we believe audiences will love watching Michelle Dockery trade in her manners for the life of a sexy, complex ex-con." I believe we should wait and see.
